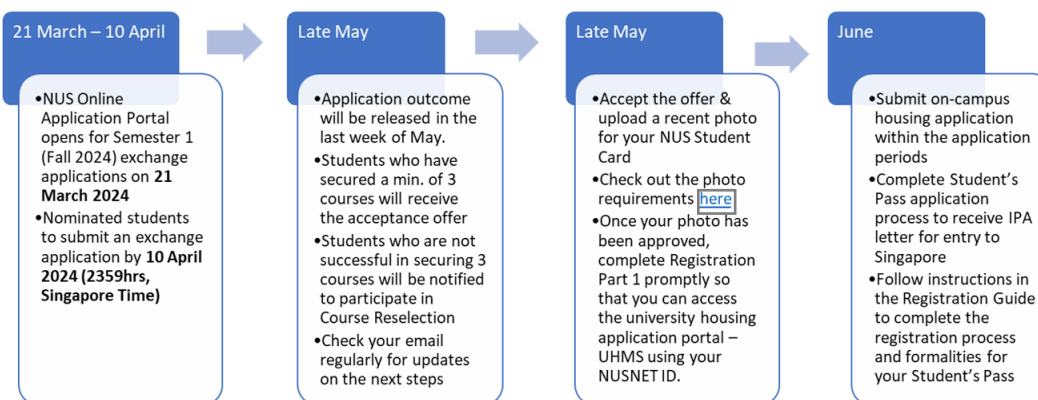

<p>to submit your exchange application with NUS from 21 March to 10 April 2024.</p> <p>To begin with, <b>register</b> a new user account <b>using your university email address</b> (instead of your personal email).</p> <p>Select "<b>Non-graduating Programme</b>" and "<b>Faculty Level</b>" for your specialisation/level of study in your application.</p> <p>You need to <b>prepare 10 courses</b> for submission with your application. Please read the course selection column for more details.</p> <p>If you require <b>on-campus housing</b>, please <b>indicate your interest</b> in your application and your <b>preferred housing options</b> – Residential College (RC) or Other Student Residences (Non-RC).</p> <p>Useful links:  <a href="#">Application Guide</a>  <a href="#">Video Guide</a></p>	<p>(Please note that NUS Semester 1, 2024 courses will be updated closer to the start of Semester 1 exchange application)</p> <p>Please check to ensure that you <b>meet the pre-requisites</b> for the courses you apply for. To be considered for higher level courses, you need to upload syllabus of the courses which you have completed at your home university to the application portal to show that you have met the pre-requisites.</p> <p>Undergraduate students should <b>select courses with course code starting from level 1000 to 4000</b>. The graduate-level courses starting from 5000 &amp; above are not offered to undergraduate students.</p> <p><b>Business and Law courses</b> are limited and <b>only offered to students nominated for Business and Law-specific exchanges</b>. University-level or other Faculty-level exchange students will not be considered for Business and Law courses. Refer to the <a href="#">Restriction List</a> for more details.</p> <p>In the recent semesters, there have been extremely <b>high demand</b> from exchange students for <b>Architecture and Computer Science courses</b> which make enrolment into these courses <b>extremely competitive</b>.</p> <p>Please note that course enrolment is <b>subject to vacancies and student demands</b>, there's no guaranteed enrolment into any specific courses.</p> <p>Please ensure to have <b>more flexibility</b> in your course selections for your exchange semester. We recommend that you <b>prepare some backup courses</b> in the event of oversubscription or timetable clashes.</p> <p>Refer to this <a href="#">link</a> for more info on course related matters.</p>	<p>On-campus accommodation is <b>limited and not guaranteed</b>. You can submit your housing application after receiving NUS admission offer and completed Registration Part 1. It will take some time for you to complete the registration process so please start early so that you can meet the housing application deadlines.</p> <p>When you login to the university housing application portal (UHMS), please select your preferred room type from the housing options available for your selection. Due to limited availability, you will not view the full list of on-campus housing. If you have any medical conditions which require special accommodations, please upload the relevant information with your housing application.</p> <p>If you are successful in your housing application, we strongly encourage you to <b>accept the offer within the acceptance deadline</b>. Failing which your room will be automatically released by the system to another student on the waiting list. <p>Please note that <b>COVID-19 vaccination</b> is still <b>required for Student's Pass holders</b>.</p> <p>You will need to be vaccinated against COVID-19 and achieve <u>minimum protection</u> before you can complete formalities for the issuance of your Student's Pass, unless you are medically exempted and certified by a Singapore doctor. Refer to this <a href="#">link</a> for more info.</p> <p>Exchange students will be covered under the <a href="#">NUS Medical Insurance Scheme</a>. Refer to the coverage for Non-graduating students.</p> <p>Students are strongly encouraged to purchase supplemental travel insurance to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.</p>	<p>have accepted the NUS admission offer around one month before the semester starts.</p> <p>You need to login to the STP application system with the information provided in the email to submit your STP application by preparing the <a href="#">required documents</a>.</p> <p>Monitor the application status regularly as you will be required to upload documents and make payments at different junctures of the application process. Please adhere to all deadlines given as failure to do so will result in your STP application being withdrawn.</p> <p>Once the STP application is approved, you will be issued an In-Principle Approval letter for entry to Singapore. For students from <a href="#">visa-required countries</a>, the IPA letter also serves as a single-entry visa to enter Singapore.</p> <p>Upon arriving in Singapore, you will still need to have the STP issued. This is primarily done through Off-Site Enrolment Sessions (OSE) offered on campus organized by The Office of the University Registrar.</p>	<div data-bbox="1185 241 1242 289" data-label="Image"> </div> <p><b>See you in NUS Webinar</b></p> <p>NUS Global will be conducting pre-arrival webinars for incoming exchange students every semester.
