It will take some time for you to complete the registration process so please start early so that you can meet the housing application d eadlines.

When you login to the university housing applicatio n portal (UHMS), please select your preferred room type from the housing options available for your sel ection. Due to limited availability, you will not be abl e to view the full list of on-campus housing.

Please indicate your housing preference as "Residen tial College" during your exchange application to be considered for this housing option. Only selected st udents will be able to apply for Residential College h ousing. However, if you would like to be considered for other housing options such as halls, houses and student residences, please select "Other Student Re sidences" in your exchange application.

Should you have any medical conditions which requi re special accommodations, please upload the relev ant information with your housing application.

When you receive the housing offer, we strongly enc ourage you to **be flexible in the allocated room typ e** and **accept the offer within the acceptance deadli ne**. Failing which, your room will be automatically re leased by the system to another student on the wait ing list. As we are working on a very tight timeline, I ate applicants or appeals for extension of deadlines will not be considered.

Exchange students should also **seek off-campus acc ommodation options concurrently** as there is incre asing demand from international students in Singap ore.
