Exchange students nominated to NUS will be referred to as Non-Graduating, Exchange students. When referencing NUS websites or documents for information, please ensure that the information is intended for Non-Graduating, Exchange students.

Submit your application to NUS	Mon, 23 Mar 2026 to Sun, 12 Apr 2026 Deadline: Sun, 12 Apr 2026, 23:59hrs SGT	<p>Nominated students will receive an email from NUSHub containing a unique application link. You can click on the application link to begin your application.</p> <p>We recommend that you indicate up to 40 units worth of relevant courses in your application to maximise your chances of securing at least 12 units of courses, to receive an offer of admission from NUS.</p> <p>Please refer to the course catalogue and course restriction list when selecting your courses. Kindly only select courses with course code starting from level 1000 to 4000, as you do not have access to graduate-level courses (level 5000 and 6000). Business and Law courses are exclusively available to students nominated for Business and Law-specific exchanges.</p>

Accept your offer of admission	Late May onwards	<p>Application outcome will be released in late May:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students who have secured at least 12 units will receive an offer of admission 2. Students who have not secured at least 12 units will be notified to participate in course reselection <p>Accept offer</p> <p>You will need to accept the offer, complete the check-in and onboarding, and upload a recent photo for your NUS student card. As part of the onboarding process, you will receive your NUS-ID, which you will need for access to NUS' housing application portal.</p> <p>Reselecting courses</p> <p>If you have not secured at least 12 units of courses, you will be contacted via your home university email to participate in course reselection.</p>
Attend pre-arrival briefing	Late May / early Jun 2026	<p>You will receive an invitation to attend the pre-arrival briefing, where you will hear directly from NUS staff regarding on-campus accommodation, courses, Student's Pass, and orientation activities.</p>

Action	Dates	Notes
Apply for on-campus accommodation	Early Jun 2026 onwards	<p>You must complete the check-in and onboarding, and secure your NUS-ID, before you can submit your application for on-campus housing on the housing application portal: https://uhms.nus.edu.sg/studentportal</p> <p>As on-campus accommodation is limited and not guaranteed, you are encouraged to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit your application early to ensure that you meet the housing application deadline 2. Remain flexible with housing options offered 3. Consider off-campus accommodation options <p>If you require special accommodation due to health conditions, please provide the relevant information in your housing application.</p>
Apply for your Student's Pass	Late May / early Jun 2026	You will receive instructions to apply for the Student's Pass (student visa) about one to two weeks after the receiving the offer of admission.
